

RESOLUTION OF THE “CENTER” MANAGEMENT BOARD NO. 1/18 OF 25 JUNE 2018 ON THE APPOINTMENT OF THE COMMISSION FOR SCIENTIFIC AWARDS FOR OUTSTANDING DOCTORATES AND MONOGRAPHS IN PUBLIC FINANCES AND TAX LAW FROM THE COUNTRIES OF CENTRAL AND EASTERN EUROPE

1.

To ensure the relevance to the distinguished scientific works in public finances and tax law from the Countries of Central and Eastern Europe as well as to popularize them more is hereby established the “Center” Commission for scientific awards for outstanding doctorates and monographs, hereinafter referred to as “the Commission”.

2.

The basic task of the Commission is to present annual, prestigious award for an outstanding doctorate or monography in public finances and tax law from the Countries of Central and Eastern Europe.

3.

This award is financial and is formally presented during the opening ceremony of the subsequent international conference of the “Center”.

4.

The composition of the Commission and its framework regulation are specified in the Attachment No. 1 and No. 2, respectively.

This Resolution comes into force on the date of its adoption.

Framework Regulation of the Commission's Rules of Procedure

1. This competition concerns doctorates and monographies awarded or published during the previous calendar year.
2. The application on receiving the award for an outstanding doctorate or monography may be submitted by the author (authors) concerned or other parties (including the Faculty Council, supervisor, reviewers, other institutions and subjects).
3. The Author shall submit a copy of the reviewed work, its 3-5 pages abstract in English and at least one review with the authorisation to use it for the purpose of the competition.
4. The Chair of the Commission decides about the initial qualification of the application for further proceeding and appoints, from among the members of the Commission, an internal reviewer of the evaluated doctorate or monography. This review should be ended by a clear conclusion to recognise or not to recognise the evaluated work as outstanding.
5. On the basis of the presented internal review and other information the Commission votes. To recognise the evaluated work as outstanding at least absolute majority of the whole composition of the Commission, pursuant to the Attachment No 1 to this Resolution, is required. In case of an equal number of votes, the vote of the Chair of the Commission counts twice.
6. If to the award applies several research works, the award is presented to the work with the highest number of positive votes of the members of the Commission.
7. The application together with the attachments should be submitted to the Secretary of the Commission till 30 June of the year following the award of the doctoral thesis or publishing of the monography. The internal review should be made till 1 September of that year.
8. The award for an outstanding doctorate or monography should have a prestigious character. Besides the quality of the awarded works, it ought to be influenced by the amount of the award, extensive publication of its results and the award ceremony. The award should be presented during the official opening ceremonies of the subsequent international scientific conferences of "the Center".
9. Due to the entry into force of these provisions during the calendar year, for the competition for doctorates and monographies awarded or published in 2017 the deadline to submit applications with the attachments, mentioned in point 7, is extended till 31 July 2018.
10. Handling complaints and motions regarding the work of the Commission rests with the "Center" Management Board.
